WITH DRIVEN WHEELS

- 2. This cultivator is designed for the rapid turning over of soil in the preparation of large gardens and other areas.
- The action of this cultivator can cause injury or damage if the machine is not used in a careful and controlled way.
- Keep your hands and feet well away from the rotating tines. 4
- If you have not used a cultivator before, practise in the middle of your area to be dug until you are confident you can use the cultivator safely.
- Plan your work and think ahead to make sure you will always be working safely.
- You must have at least the following items of personal protective equipment: Ear 7. muffs or plugs giving protection for levels up to 90 db(A); Safety boots (EN345 or BS1870/4972) to protect feet and ankles; Strong gloves for handling any rubbish
- This machine must not be used by minors, or by anyone under the influence of
- drugs or alcohol.
- either temporary or permanent disability must seek expert advice before using it.
