Using the Wacker Rammer

- Wear your protective equipment including ear defenders and safety boots
- With the engine running, open the throttle lever fully to start the vibration action, then adjust to obtain an even jumping action.
- Hold the rammer vertically when you are using it.
- This machine moves forward, and can be turned easily, while the vibration action is on. Be careful not to strain yourself by moving it while the engine is not running.
- Always keep your hands, feet and any loose clothing away from moving parts of the compactor.
- Watch out for signs that vibration may be affecting your hands. If your fingers start to tingle or feel numb, take a short break from using the machine. Exercise your fingers to encourage blood circulation.
- To help prevent vibration affecting your hands, operate the machine for shorter periods. Keep your hands warm - wearing gloves may help do this.
- To stop the vibration without stopping the engine, fully close the throttle.
- When the compactor is not being operated, stop the engine and turn off the fuel valve. If you need to leave the compactor unattended, lay it down, or lean it against a strong support to prevent it being knocked over.
- 10. If your equipment does not work properly do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire company.
- 11. You may want to read this leaflet again. Please keep it until you finish work. Keep this leaflet safe as it may be required for reference at a future date

Wacker Rammer

The rules and procedures in force where people are at work may require the person responsible for this equipment to carry out a specific risk assessment.

- Plan your work and think ahead to make sure you will always be working safely.

- If you have not used a Wacker rammer before, familiarise yourself with the machine in an open safe area before you start on the main task
- You must have at least the following items of personal protective equipment: ear muffs or plugs giving protection for levels up to 96 dB(A); safety boots and gloves.
- This machine must not be used by minors, or by anyone under the influence of drugs or


